

Questions for Careers in Students' Unions Career Pathways Map

We love to use the Career Pathways feature on the Careers in Students' Unions site to help showcase the journeys of the amazing and diverse people who already work in the movement, so that we can help attract even more like-minded folk to work here!

The Career Pathways Map is one place where we showcase the people working in the movement, the roles they do, what they love about their work, and their journey/route to get to where they are today. Their stories will help attract other people to the movement.

We'd like to invite you and your staff to submit your own stories of how you got to where you are today, for us to showcase under the relevant role titles on the site.

The main thing is we want to help use the Career Pathways Map to showcase how people can have a career in the movement, and how much we value diversity and the individuality of staff.

What to do next:

- Identify a willing volunteer (or group of volunteers) from your current staff.
- Ask them to answer the questions below. The maximum wordcount we are looking for is around 300 words.

2. What's the best thing about your role?
3. How did you get here?
4. What's was the most helpful piece of learning you picked up along the way?
5. What would you say to someone that was considering a role in the student movement?
